

Holy Week (April 4-10, 2012)

Holy Thursday

The Last Supper: When you eat this bread and drink this cup you proclaim the Lord's death, until He comes again. I Corinthians 11:26

Maundy Thursday's emphasis on ritual washing also gave rise to the ancient tradition of spring cleaning, evidently related to the Jewish custom of ritually cleaning the home in preparation for the Feast of Passover.

Good Friday

Veneration of the Cross: In the symbol of the Cross we can see the magnitude of the human tragedy, the ravages of original sin, and the infinite love of God. Because the Cross is inseparable from His sacrifice, in reverencing His Cross we, in effect, adore Christ. Thus we affirm: 'We adore Thee, O Christ, and we bless Thee because by Thy Holy Cross Thou has Redeemed the World.' Holy Week is a particularly appropriate time to attempt to penetrate the true meaning of this sacred image through prayerful contemplation.
